Who may be eligible for Veterans Treatment Court?

- An adult charged with a misdemeanor and/or felony in Butler County who is a veteran or active in the military and who has a mental health diagnosis (including traumatic brain injury) and/or drug & alcohol issues.

Who is not eligible for Veterans Treatment Court?

- Defendants charged with Homicide, Sexual offenses, assault by a prisoner, drug trafficking
- Defendants requesting a jury trial
- Defendants with an out of county or state detainer, or who have only probation violation cases

- Cases of aggravated assault, burglary, robbery, Violation of Uniform Firearms Act (VUFA) and situations involving a dishonorable discharge from the military will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
